Dates & Times

Classes are held from **5:15-6:05pm and 6:15-7:05pm** and consist of **50 minutes of instruction**.

Classes start **October 16, 2017** and run for 24 weeks until April 9, 2018. There will be NO lessons on Christmas Day & New Year's Day.

We will also be offering a Spring Session this year from April 16, 2018 to June 11, 2018 from 5:15-6:05pm only. There will be NO Lessons on Memorial Day.

Classes are held every Monday. Please note that the *Hockey Fundamentals* class will only be held in the 5:15-6:05 hour, and the *Hockey Advanced Skills* and *Advanced Figure Skating* classes will only be held in the 6:15-7:05 hour.

Severe weather may cause classes to be canceled. Classes lost this way **cannot** be made up or refunded. In cases of inclement weather, please call the rink at (978) 535-2110 after 2pm or Darlene at (781) 305-3555.

Course Fee

Payment is divided into three installments. The installment fee will be prorated for those that start later in the program.

Classes are \$17 for 50 minutes of instruction. Sibling discounts are available, please contact Darlene for more information.

The first installment for 10 weeks is **\$195.00** (\$170 + \$25 non-refundable registration fee) must be sent in with the registration form. The second installment for 14 weeks is **\$238.00** is due Monday January 8, 2018. The third installment for 8 weeks is **\$136.00** due, Monday, April 16, 2018. If new student register during second or third session, registration will be due at that time.

Refund Policy

We want to make sure that **all** skaters come to class because they want to, not just because it's been paid for. As such, in the student's first two weeks of classes, you may withdraw from the program and we will refund your course fee, less the registration fee and fee for the classes they have attended.

Exhibition

We end each year with our Annual Skating Exhibition. The last 4 weeks of the second session we will have 25 minutes of lesson and 25 minutes of practice time for the Exhibition. It is very informal and more information will follow as we get closer to that time of year. There is no additional cost for the Exhibition.

Badge Testing

As a member of Learn to Skate USA, we evaluate each skater based on the Learn to Skate USA curriculum and will conduct Badge Testing at the end of each session. Students will earn badges based on their progress. Freestyle students may have to re-skate the prior badge level due to curriculum changes made by Learn to Skate USA. Also, skaters will continue to receive Testing books, however going forward they will be mailed directly to your home from Learn to Skate USA.

The cost for Badges are \$2.00

Hockey Skating Skills

Hockey Fundamentals: This curriculum is designed to teach the basics of recreational and hockey skating to skaters aged 4-7 with little or no experience. In this class, the skaters will learn the skills they need to successfully maneuver on the ice. All elements will be taught **without a stick or puck**, as the focus of this class is on proper skating techniques, not on the game of hockey itself.

Hockey Advanced Skills: This class is for kids age 8 and up who have mastered basic skating skills or are currently playing on a hockey team. Using a wide range of drills and exercises, this class will concentrate on strengthening speed, endurance, balance, and agility while developing the basic skills of forward skating, backward skating, stopping, turning, edges, and crossovers.

Skates & Helmets

For students looking to buy new skates, we *recommend Cooke's Skate Supply* (978-657-7586); *The Sharper Edge* (978-535-9918) and *Woody's Pro Shop* right at the rink (978-535-1175). Rentals are also available at Woody's each week.

Skates should be sharpened with a **hollow ground** even if they are new skates. This can be done right at *Woody's Pro Shop*.

Helmets are required for all skaters ages 4-10 years old or until they have passed Basic 4. Skaters will not be allowed on the ice without a helmet. For Hockey classes helmets are mandatory for ALL levels, no matter what age.

Injury Waivers

The Peabody Skating Club registration form includes an injury waiver. **It must be signed and returned in order for your child to participate.**
