## Registration

Our program consists of weekly classes that run for 30 weeks starting **October 19, 2026**. Students can register and join the class any time throughout the program as long as there is space left in the class.

## Dates & Times

Classes are held at the **McVann O'Keefe Skating Rink**, 511 Lowell Street from **5:15-6:05pm** and **6:15-7:05pm** and consist of **50 minutes of instruction**.

Classes start **October 19, 2026** and run for 30 weeks until **May 24, 2027**.

Classes are held every **Monday**. Please note that the Advanced Figure Skating / Free Skate and Adult classes will only be held in the 6:15-7:05 hour.

Severe weather may cause classes to be canceled. Classes lost this way **cannot** be made up or refunded. In cases of inclement weather, please call the rink at (978) 535-2110 after 2pm or Darlene at (781) 305-3555. Students may take double classes to make up for absences due to illness, NO refunds will be given.

## Course Fee

Payment is divided into three installments. Each installment fee will be prorated for those that start later in the program. Each Session must be paid in full no later than the third (3) week of class. Classes are \$25 for 50 minutes of instruction, so long as paid in advance.

All skaters will be required to pay a yearly Registration Fee on the first night of class in the amount of \$20.00 for registration to USFSA Learnt to Skate USA.

The first installment for the **Fall Session (10 weeks)** is **\$270.00**. Session 1 will run from October 19, 2026 to December 21, 2026, which includes registration fee.

The second installment for the **Winter Session (12 weeks)** is **\$300.00** paid on the first night of the session. Session 2 will run from January 4, 2027 to March 22, 2027..

The third installment for the **Spring Session (9 weeks)** is **\$225.00** paid on the first night of the session. Session 3 will run from March 29, 2027 to May 24, 2027. **Spring Session will only run at 5:15-6:05PM.**

Sibling Discount Available ONLY IF Session is paid in FULL on first night of class.

Second Child \$23 per week / Third Child \$20 per week

**Please make all checks payable to Peabody Skating Club.**

**Please be advised that NO parents or spectators will be allowed to sit in the hockey boxes or to stand by the rink doors. We find that this is a distraction to the coaches and the students. There is plenty of seating in bleachers.**

## Refund Policy

We want to make sure that **all** skaters come to class because they want to, not just because it's been paid for. As such, during first two (2) weeks of classes, you may withdraw from the program and we will refund your course fee, less lesson fees and registration for the classes they have attended. No refunds will be provided after two (2) weeks.

## Badge Testing

As a member of Learn to Skate USA, we evaluate each skater based on the Learn to Skate USA curriculum and will conduct Badge Testing at the end of each session. Students will earn badges based on their progress. Also, skaters will continue to receive Testing books, however going forward they will be mailed directly to your home from Learn to Skate USA as part of welcome package

## Hockey Skating Skills

*Hockey Fundamentals:* This curriculum is designed to teach the basics of recreational and hockey skating to skaters with little or no experience. In this class, the skaters will learn the skills they need to successfully maneuver on the ice. All elements will be taught **without a stick or puck**, as the focus of this class is on proper skating techniques, not on the game of hockey itself. Skaters must have completed Basic 2 prior to entering Hockey Skating Skills.

## Skates & Helmets

For students looking to buy new skates, we *recommend* *Cooke's Skate Supply* (978-657-7586); *The Sharper Edge* (978-535-9918) and *Woody's Pro Shop* right at the rink (978-535-1175). **Rentals are also available at Woody's each week.**

Skates should be sharpened with a ***hollow ground*** even if they are new skates. This can be done right at *Woody's Pro Shop*.

Helmets are required for all skaters ages 3-10 years old or until they have passed Basic 4. Skaters will not be allowed on the ice without a helmet. For Hockey classes helmets are mandatory for ALL levels, no matter what age.

## Injury Waivers

The Peabody Skating Club registration form includes an injury waiver. **It must be signed and returned in order for your child to participate.**
